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BARBER ORGANIZING DRIVE CHECKLIST

This document will guide you through the submission process and help you understand what Local 798 will be looking for in reviewing your application.

Check List:

- Local 798 pre-membership application form
- Local 798 Union Authorization Form
- Current resume. Must be for the craft of Hair (Barber)
- A Copy of your Barber or Master Barber License
- 3 Letter of Recommendation from people with whom you have worked **two of which must be Local 798 Members**. The other can be producers, production managers, actors, or other industry professional.
- Proof of 18 months of residency in Local 798's jurisdiction.
- Proof of 90 days worked on productions in Local 798's craft jurisdiction. Proof of days must be for Film, TV, or Theater or Video these production classification are covered under Local 798 contracts. Proof of days must be paid work and can be non-union as well as union.

APPLICATION MATERIALS:

1. **Local 798 Pre-Member Application Forms** – complete all sections of the applications, then sign and date the forms.
2. **Local 798 Union Authorization Form**- Complete all sections of the form and sign
3. **Resume** – provide one copy of your current resume. Please make your resume as complete as possible. Resumes should include the following information:
 - a. Your Name, Address, Contact Information
 - b. Name of Producer(s), Production Company, or Theater
 - c. Title of Production
 - d. Name of the Director and/or Department Head
 - e. Date and Year of production.
 - f. Education and copy of Barbers or Master Barbers License
 - g. Names of References providing Recommendations and contact information
4. **Recommendations** – Please choose three (3) individuals who will recommend your work and character with whom you have worked, 2 of which must be Local 798 members. Please have them complete a Local 798 Recommendation Forms.

Local 798 members are most aware of the abilities needed to function in our profession and therefore their recommendation carries the most weight. They should speak to your skills in the craft as well as your suitability as a Local 798 member.

Producers, directors, actors or other industry professionals who belong to another union or guild may provide the recommendations. These people must be aware of an applicant's artistic ability, as well as their practical knowledge and ability to function well on the job. **Please do NOT request recommendations from people with whom you have NOT worked.**

5. **Proof of 18 months Residency in Local 798's Jurisdiction** – This program is only open to residents of Local 798's jurisdiction. Provide copies of two (2) of the following documents: driver's license, utility bill, lease, or mortgage statement as proof of your-residency.

REVIEW PROCESS:

A panel comprised of Local 798 members will review your application. They will evaluate your resume and read your recommendations to assess your qualifications to be a member of Makeup Artists-and Hair Stylists of Local 798. Emphasis will be placed on the judgment of current Local 798 members who are recommending you for membership.

Applications must be submitted with *all* required materials. Incomplete applications will be discarded after the deadline.

MEMBERSHIP DUES & FEES:

Members invited to join as part of the Barber Organizing Drive will be responsible for all Initiation fees and application fees of \$3500.00 Those accepted under this program will be required to attend a Membership Orientation Class and are encouraged to attend Health & Safety, Craft, and other classes when available.
